Puppy Development Classes

The class is for puppies between 7 weeks and 16 weeks. In this class we will cover puppy manners (i.e. jumping, chewing, barking, walking on a leash and house breaking,) management systems and intro to basic obedience. The fee for this class is \$105.00* for five weekly one-hour sessions.

Next puppy class will begin May 5th

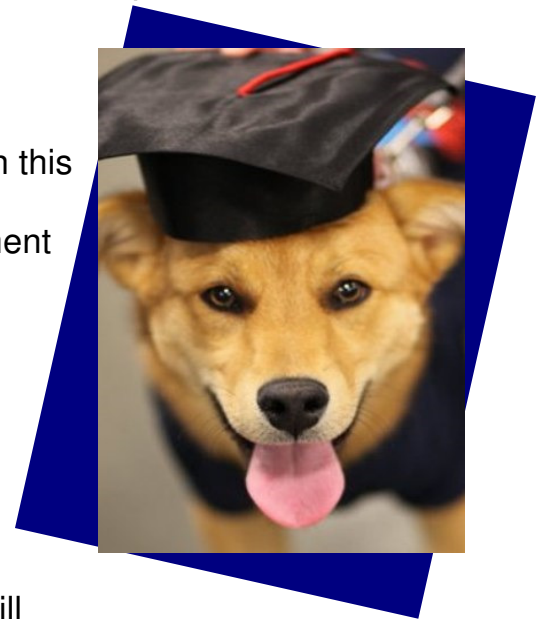
Basic Obedience Class

The class is for dogs 4 months and older. In this class we will cover basic on leash commands such as come, sit, down, place, off, quiet and free. You and your four legged friend will learn the foundation of obedience to help improve the quality of life you share with each other. We will also cover confidence building, aggression and submissive control in young dogs. The fee for this class is \$125.00* for five weekly 90 minute sessions.

In order to maintain a high level of safety and protection for all dogs enrolled in classes please check the following information to be sure your dog is up to date with our vaccine requirements.

Puppies:

- **DHPP:** starting at 7 -8 weeks of age and continuing every 3 – 4 weeks until past 16 weeks of age
- **Bordetella:** at 12 weeks
- **Rabies:** 1 year at 16 weeks of age
- **Fecal** check with no parasites seen for 6 months
- **Leptospirosis** at appropriate age

Adult dogs:

- **DHP** - Distemper, Hepatitis and Parvovirus Prevention: must have been administered by SylvaniaVET or another veterinarian within the last 3 years.
- **Leptospirosis, Bordetella/Parainfluenza** Prevention: must have been administered within the last year.
- **Fecal Exam:** No parasites found within the last 6 months

Potential Diseases Dogs Are Exposed To:

Distemper: A viral disease causing fever, diarrhea, respiratory problems, and convulsions. Often fatal.

Hepatitis: A viral disease that attacks the liver and other organs.

Parainfluenza: A highly contagious, airborne virus. Causes a harsh, hacking cough (one form of "kennel cough"). Vaccine only partially protective.

Parvovirus: Highly contagious. Causes severe bloody diarrhea, vomiting, and fever. Can be fatal.

Rabies: A viral disease causing temperament changes, inability to swallow, and convulsions. **Ultimately fatal. Affects almost all warm-blooded animals, including humans.**

Leptospirosis: A bacterial disease transmitted through contaminated water. Causes fever, vomiting, liver and kidney failure. Potentially contagious to humans.

If you are a current client of Sylvania Vet, your records can be reviewed when you enroll in classes.

If you are a client from another vet hospital, please bring (or mail) a copy of your current vaccine records along with your registration.
